Commencing at the Heritage Centre, Caroline will lead us on a guided tour of Knutsford, visiting the locations where extraordinary women lived and worked, and will tell us of their personal stories, and the contributions that they made, in their historic period, to the social development of Knutsford.

Whilst walking around Knutsford with Caroline you will hear the stories of these remarkable women. Among them are writers, an aristocrat, an educational pioneer, another who offended Indian sensibilities in Calcutta, rich and poor - all have a story worth telling. Some will be familiar to you including Elizabeth Gaskell, and perhaps Lady Jane Stanley - but there will be a few surprises along the way!

The walks take about an hour and start in the Heritage Centre shop.
